Ipod nano bag pattern

Materials

1 x ball Louisa Harding Glisten (we used shade 13)

1 x set 5mm double pointed (dpn) needles

1 x 5mm crochet hook

Instructions

Using 5mm dpn, cast on 25 sts. Spread these sts over 3 dpn's.

Knit in the round in stocking stitch (knit every row) for 35 rows.

Cast off 3 sts.

Arrange remaining 22 sts over 2 needles with the 3 cast off sts to one side.

Holding the 2 needles together in left hand, knit across 11 sts, taking one from the front needle and one from the back needle and knitting them together. AT THE SAME TIME, cast off, fasten off but do not cut yarn.

With 5mm crochet hook and the yarn which is still attached, work 1 double crochet into each row of knitting up the side of the pocket until approximately 4 rows from the top.

Work 200 chains.

Starting on the 5th row from the top of the pocket, work 1 double crochet into each row of knitting down the remaining side of the pocket

until you reach the bottom. Fasten off. Darn in end.
